Based on the information and documentation provided to us by our supplier, we hereby state the following:

This includes to keep the safety data sheets up to date, to provide updated safety data sheets to customers and downstream users and to update the layout of cans, if required.

The product **Multi Tech PTFE** does not pose a risk to the objects treated with them, because the hazardous substances that led to the labeling of the product evaporate during use, are chemically changed to harmless substances or are so firmly integrated into the matrix of the object that they do not pose a risk.
