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SECTION 4: First aid measures

* 4.1. Description of first aid measures

General information:

Do not leave affected person unattended. Remove victim out of the danger area. If unconscious, position and transport in stable lateral position. Do not allow anything to be taken by mouth. Take off contaminated clothing and wash it before reuse. If in doubt, or if you experience any symptoms, contact a doctor.

Following inhalation:

The selection of a suitable glove depends not only on the material but also on other quality features and varies from manufacturer to manufacturer.
